To apply for Safari in northern Botswana (8 days/7 nights):

We will pay individually and directly to our safari company with our deposits and balance for the Botswana Safari. We are booking through Conservation Safaris Inc. in Johannesburg. Our agent is Garrick Barnard.

We will request the company to also book our two airfares (from Cape Town to Maun and from Victoria to Johannesburg to be booked later) so that we can go as a group.

Our deposits are crucial for us hold the camp space in the two camps - each with space for 14 that are being held for us. Since we have rebooked this safari they again set a very tight date for us – **deposit due Nov 1** – to each pay our **deposit of \$1050** per person. They may give me a bit of leeway on ambassadors not yet selected - but they won't hold these camp spaces forever; in fact, we lost one camp space and our hotel in Victoria when I canceled in July. But the two new options belong to the same people and are of equal quality. The deposit per person is due as soon as we book our company to hold our safari spaces, which we have done.

I will provide the safari company with a list of participants for the safari and they will send you an invoice and this amount can be paid by credit card on their secure site or by bank transfer if you prefer, with a small discount if you pay by bank transfer.

We do have a full trip of 16, with many applicants now vying for our remaining spaces – those people to be decided in the next day or so. We should have a waiting list as well in case circumstances require you to cancel.

Yes - traveling to Africa is a lot of money. If you check commercial tours for the same things we are doing, you will be looking at a cost at least what this one is up to double what this trip costs. If you ever plan to go to southern Africa, you will probably never find as good a deal as this one. We will also have the great experience of meeting new friends in the Cape Town at a discount price and enjoying beautiful South Africa.
